





# **Opening Plenary Session**

During the opening plenary session on the first day, a keynote speaker will introduce the theme and provide an overview of the key urban issues in the Asian region. These issues will subsequently be addressed by a high-level panel and discussed by Forum participants focusing on strategies to overcome obstacles and transform Asian cities into 'cities of opportunity.' This transformation aims to catalyze sustainable development that is both inclusive and environmentally conscious. The opening session will witness several regional leaders highlighting and deliberate on their vision and policy directions in the coming decades for enhanced ambition and accelerated climate actions in Asian cities.

### **Forum Theme**

The UrbanShift Forums will provide a platform for participants to exchange insights on addressing challenges, showcasing successful practices, and investigating scalable strategies. Additionally, participants will explore avenues for support from the UrbanShift project, including knowledge and capacity building as well as financial and private sector engagement opportunities. Moreover, cities from the same region will be invited to share their experiences with UrbanShift cities, with a special focus on those recognized as regional leaders, GEF-6 cities, and Least Developed Countries (LDCs).

**Thematic Focus:** The Asia Forum will concentrate on the theme of 'Financing Climate Actions in Cities.

The Forum will encompass multiple events and activities which will rest on three pillars:

- (a) Advocacy and climate action,
- (b) Knowledge sharing and capacity building, and
- (c) Finance and Private Sector Engagement.

#### **Translation with Regional Focus**

The forum is designed as a regional event, with its primary audience consisting of representatives from all the project countries and cities in the Asian region. As a result, the opening plenary aims to offer simultaneous translations in commonly spoken regional languages, including English, Mandarin, and Bahasa Indonesia.
